ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom,
Canada and Her other Realms and Territories, Queen, Head of the
Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith

To all to whom these presents shall come – Greeting

WHEREAS family caregivers are a vital part of the health care team, providing care and support to individuals who are frail, elderly, chronically ill or living with a disability in long-term care, community and home settings, and

WHEREAS the role of the family caregiver has become even more important with the growing complexity of care needs, an aging population and the shift to community-based care, and

WHEREAS recognition is due to family caregivers for their dedication and commitment to improving quality of life for their friends and family members, often under conditions that impede their own physical, emotional and financial health and wellness;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that May 2021 shall be known as

“Family Caregiver Month”

in the Province of British Columbia.
